32	Number of new government programs created at a cost of \$136 billion in the House bill
\$2,700	The amount of money every American would receive if the stimulus bill were distributed evenly
\$6,700	Amount of additional debt to every American household in the House bill
10,000	Jobs created at NASA at a cost to taxpayers of \$1.5 billion under the Senate bill
\$203,667	Cost per job created at the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration by Senate bill
\$734,426	Cost per job created at the International Boundary and Water Commission by Senate bill
860,000	Number of properties repossessed in 2008, and yet still no housing provisions in the Senate stimulus bill
\$1,350,000	Cost per job created at the State Department's Capital Investment Fund by the Senate stimulus bill
1,900,000	Jobs lost in the past four months, and only 7% percent of spending in the Senate bill will be spent by the end of FY09
\$20,000,000	For removal of small to medium-sized fish passage barriers in Senate bill.
\$25,000,000	To rehabilitate off-roading ATV trails under the Senate bill
\$34,000,000	For remodeling the Department of Commerce headquarters in Senate bill

\$150,000,000 Spent on honey bee insurance in the Senate bill

\$400,000,000 Dedicated to STD prevention in Senate bill

\$650,000,000 For digital TV coupons in House bill

\$1,502,000,000 Spent at NASA to hire 10,000 people in Senate bill

\$6,000,000,000 To colleges and universities – many of which have billion dollar endowments –
in the House bill
